1. Transnational Project Meetings: The first event, hosted by AFAD, was a two-day project kick-off meeting with the participation of ESDP, Asystee Ed.Tech, and Eskişehir provincial officials. The introductory meeting, held in person, focused on getting to know each other, project management and coordination, risk planning, financial regulations, dissemination efforts, and clarifying activities and responsibilities. Administrative and financial presentations were made. The event also featured experience sharing with representatives of related partners who have previously worked in disasters, construction equipment operators, and infrastructure and superstructure workers. The event also featured a press launch, promoting the project through the media. The closing meeting was held online to evaluate the project results, with representatives from ESDP, Asystee Ed.Tech, and AFAD.













2. Learning, Teaching, and Training Event: A three-day training and education event hosted by project partner ESDP in Madrid, Spain, with the participation of AFAD, Asystee Ed.Tech, and Spanish partner organizations. The event included cross-skills practice and training to develop project outcomes.













3. Proje Çıktıları Geliştirme Faaliyetleri: Projede somut olarak eRehber (TR, EN, ES), Uzaktan Eğitim Platformu (TR, EN, ES) ve Simülasyon Modülü (13 farklı ciddi oyun)' den oluşan 3 farklı dilde dijital eğitim çıktıları geliştirilmiştir.









4. Multiplier Events Training seminars and drills were held under the coordination of Eskişehir AFAD with the participation of professionals from the construction and mining sectors, infrastructure, sewerage, and superstructure sectors, and construction equipment operators. At the event, project results were introduced to the target group, and they were given hands-on experience through field exercises.





































5. Dissemination Activities: Within the scope of the "Ready4RescEU" project, which focuses on improving the interoperability skills of occupational groups in the construction, technical works and mining sectors in disaster and emergency situations, the project results were presented with the participation of AFAD volunteers, construction equipment operators, infrastructure and superstructure technical personnel and workers from public, private sector and non-governmental organizations, hosted by Hatay AFAD on 10-11 June 2025 and K.Maraş AFAD on 12 June 2025.















The first transnational dissemination activity of the Ready4RescEU project was held in Germany, hosted by the partner organization "ISAR Germany," with the participation









of Eskişehir AFAD and Duisburg disaster response authorities. The event introduced the project outcomes and outlined a roadmap for disseminating the project results to relevant units across Germany and Europe.













In the second leg of the activities, a study visit was conducted in Madrid, Spain, to the Civil Protection Unit of the Spanish Ministry of the Interior and the Spanish Canine Search and Rescue Agency. Collaboration was established to disseminate the project results throughout Spain and Europe. An agreement was reached with the associated partner organization "IAE Rescue" in Valencia to promote the project results and disseminate them to the target group.
